

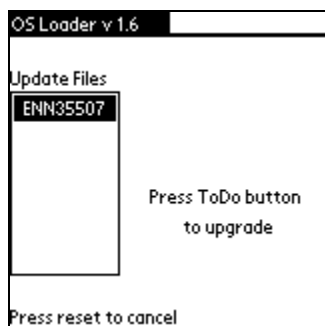
Upgrading System Flash on HandEra Handhelds via the Compact Flash slot.

Warning: *Upgrading the System Flash will wipe out the RAM and flash on your device. Make sure to either perform a HotSync or run Backup in order to backup your unit.*

Note: *Files copied to flash using FlashPro will be erased as well.*

Installation

1. Backup data using Backup or HotSync. You should also backup any data stored in flash; the flash memory of the device will be erased.
2. Check you small ROM date. Go to the applications menu item "System Info..." If the Small ROM: entry exists and is 3/6/00 or newer skip to step 4, otherwise perform step 3. If you have a HandEra 330 skip to step 4.
3. Move the program SmUpdate.prc onto the device via HotSync, CardPro or beaming. Run SmUpdate on the device and click on the "Update Small ROM" button. SmUpdate will no longer be needed on the device after it has been run.
4. Copy the included .UPD file into the ROOT of the CF memory card from your desktop/laptop computer.
5. Insert the CF memory card into the device.
6. While holding down the Date Book button (next to the power button), press and release the reset button. The screen should appear as in Figure 1.



7. Press the To-Do button to perform the update.
8. Restore data using Backup or HotSync.
9. Delete any copies of FlashPro restored to RAM in step 8 and run the backup of FlashPro that was installed into flash by this update to get the latest version into RAM.
10. You may delete the upgrade file from the CF card at this time.
